**Masking Guidelines:** We have created a special section at the front of the church for the immuno-compromised folks in our midst. In this section, folks are required to wear exclusively N-95 masks at all times, and be socially distanced between households. Anyone is free to use this section, as long as these rules are followed.

In the remainder of the church, including the chancel, parishioners may remove their masks while in the pews.

While moving about the space, including entering, exiting, and moving to receive communion, parishioners will put their masks back on. This is to ensure everyone is safe while we move through sometimes crowded hallways and doorways, and past our protected special section.

In the chapel, masks will continue to be worn due to the size of the space.
